



6th Form Admission Appeals Information

Appeals can only be lodged after GCSE results are released

GCSE Results Day Thursday 20 August 2020

If you did not gain the required results for your chosen 6th form pathway, you can still appeal (although you may be unsuccessful)

- Appeals must be lodged within **30 school days after** GCSE results day

Please download a copy of the appeal form from the school website

- Complete and return the form stating your grounds for appeal, together with any supporting documents, to:

- Appeals are heard by an Independent Appeals Panel within **40 school days after** the deadline for lodging grounds for appeal.
- You will be notified of the date, time and location of the appeal hearing **10 school days in advance** (you may waive the right to 10 days' notice of the appeal if you wish).
- Evidence in support of your appeal must be submitted at least **10 school days** in advance of the hearing date.
- Papers are circulated (where possible) **5 school days** before the hearing.
- Decision letters are sent **5 school days** after the Panel has made its decision.
