Bishop Justus CE Football Academy Code of Conduct

Please sign and return this code of conduct to Mr. Crush, as confirmation that you have read and agree to the Bishop Justus CE Football Academy.

1. Attendance at sixth form must be a minimum of 96% or above – if not met then removal from the team and the Academy will occur unless there is medical evidence to support absence.
2. Attendance and reliability at training or matches is 96% or above. Even when injured attendance will be expected.
3. All deadlines for coursework and home learning must be met, otherwise removal from training, matches and the Academy will occur.
4. All players must attend all sixth form events, such as open evenings, parents evenings and awards evenings.
5. Show self-discipline in terms of language and behaviour at school as well as at training and matches.
6. Correct kit and footwear to be worn at all times at School, training and matches (please refer to Sixth Form Dress Code).
7. Play to the best of your ability and within the spirit of the game at all times.
8. Respect the coaches, officials, supporters and opposition at all times during matches and training sessions.
9. Adhere to any personal fitness plan issued by the school or academy.
10. All players will play a maximum of 2 matches per week to ensure overuse injuries do not occur.
11. All players that are not able to train or play must let the Head Coach know as soon as possible. Contact must be direct and not via another player or student.
12. Respect all facilities including minibus and equipment used e.g. training balls, bibs, discs, kit etc.
13. Any player who feels threatened, intimidated, bullied or discriminated against should report this to the Director of the Academy or Sixth Form Leadership Team, as soon as possible.
14. Any player who is found to be under the influence of drugs or alcohol will be subjected to Bishop Justus Disciplinary Procedures.
15. Remember at all times you are a role model and adhere to the standard of behaviour required by Bishop Justus Church of England School and The Football Academy.
